- 2005: Becomes Latin America's top bank with 3,554 branches in Brazil, Mexico and Chile. Latin America accounts for 32% of profits
- 2007: Buys Dutch bank ABN Amro in joint deal with Belgian-Dutch bank Fortis and Royal Bank of Scotland
 2008: Buys UK mortgage lenders
- Alliance & Leicester for €1.57 billion and Bradford & Bingley for €773 million. Becomes Britain's second largest bank with 24.6 million
