▲ 2005: The military government in Burma began moving all government ministries from Rangoon to a new, purpose-built capital 600km to the north, officially named Nay Pyi Daw

1911: Francisco Madero became president of Mexico after leading the revolution against dictator Porfirio Diaz

1923: Inflation in Germany soared to 4.2 trillion marks to the U.S. dollar

1970: Italy and China established diplomatic relations

2007: At least 40 people, including six MPs and many schoolchildren, were killed in a suicide attack in northern Afghanistan
