▲ **1871: *Dr Livingstone, I presume?*** enquired Henry Stanley on finding missing explorer David Livingstone at Ujiji, in present day Tanzania

1493: Swiss physician and alchemist Paracelsus, who established the role of chemistry in medicine, was born

1928: Hirohito was formally crowned Emperor of Japan having being Regent for eight years

1989: Todor Zhikov stepped down as Bulgaria's Communist Party chief and head of state after 35 years in power
