▲ 1630: German astronomer Johannes Kepler, who discovered the principles of planetary motion and pioneered work with modern optics and calculus, died at age 58

1889: Brazil was declared a republic

1920: Danzig (now Gdansk, Poland) was proclaimed a free city under the terms of the Treaty of Versailles

1935: Manuel Quezon was inaugurated as first president of the Commonwealth of the Philippines

2007: U.S. baseball star Barry Bonds was indicted by a federal grand jury for perjury, having allegedly lied under oath about his use of steroids
