▲ 1869: The Hudson's Bay Company ceded its vast territories in North America to the newly established Dominion of Canada. They were renamed the Northwest Territories

**1828:** Austrian composer Franz Schubert died from typhoid at age 31

1946: The first UNESCO conference opened in Paris

**1990:** Leaders of NATO and the Warsaw Pact declared the end of the Cold War

2007: As many as 10,000 people were killed and seven million lives were left devastated after Cyclone Sidr swept through Bangladesh
