▲ **1929: Catalan artist Salvador Dali held his first one-man show in Paris**

1962: The Cuban Missile Crisis ended when President Kennedy agreed to lift the U.S. blockade after Soviet bombers were removed from the island

1980: Jiang Qing, widow of Mao Zedong, went on trial in China on charges of treason

1998: The first section of the International Space Station was blasted into orbit from Kazakhstan

2007: The UK government admitted it had lost two computer discs containing personal data and bank details of over 25 million people
