"The unreturning army that was youth"

The Great War claimed the lives of 10 million fighting men and appalling civilian losses. Believed to be "the war to end all war", the conflict destroyed the old European order and, once the guns finally fell silent on November 11, 1918, usbered in a new era of global politics.
