
Who's the brain behind the Mumbai attacks?

The prime suspect in the terrorist attacks on Mumbai is Abdul Subhan Qureshi, a 36-year-old computer engineer who is also believed to have masterminded multiple bombings throughout India earlier this year

4 Jul 27-28, Surat:

3 Jul 26, Ahmedabad:

- 5 Sep 13, New Delhi: Five bombs kill 21 people; Sep 27, bomb kills one
- 6 Oct 30, Assam: Eleven bombs kill at least 64 people
- **7 Nov 26, Mumbai:** Multiple attacks kill 101 people. Hostages held at two luxury hotels and Jewish centre
