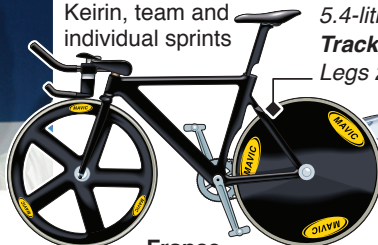


Man versus machine at Wembley's Race of Champions

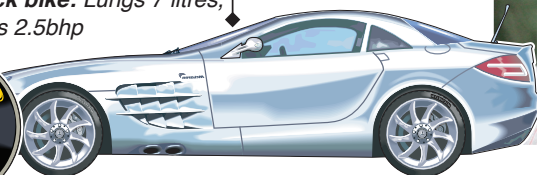

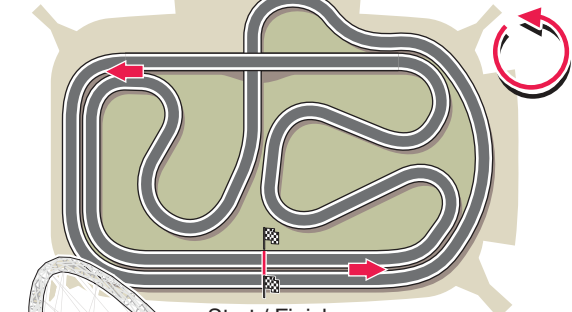

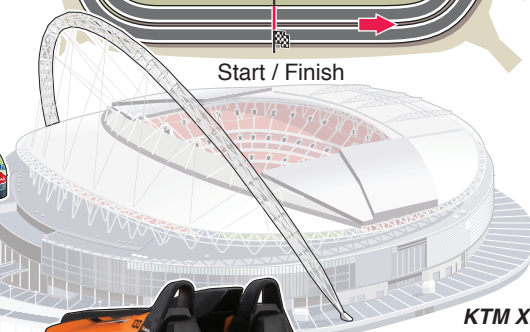
