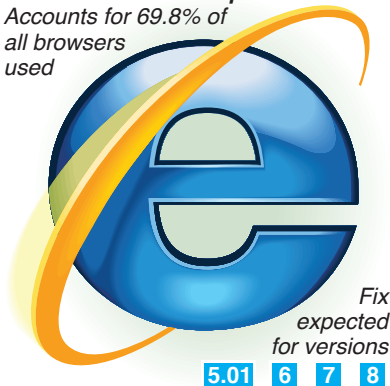


Microsoft security flaw

A critical vulnerability discovered in the world's most widely-used browser could potentially allow criminals to seize control of computers and steal private data

IMPROVE YOUR PC SECURITY

IE7 or IE8b2: Use *Protected Mode*

Windows Server 2003/2008: Higher security is applied to websites which are not on the IE *Trusted sites* list
