

Russian gas through Ukraine to Europe halted

Exports of Russian gas to Europe via Ukraine have stopped completely amid a dispute over gas supplies. The European Union depends on Russia for about a quarter of its total gas supplies, some 80 percent of which is pumped through Ukraine
