▲ **1547: Edward VI was enthroned as King of England following the death of his father, Henry VIII**

1707: Aurangzeb, last of the great Mughal Emperors of India, died

1809: After rejecting Joseph Bonaparte as King of Spain, the city of Zaragoza finally fell to the French after a lengthy siege

1971: An emergency warning of a nuclear attack was broadcast in the U.S. in error, triggering widespread fear

2001: Bloody clashes broke out between migrants and indigenous Dayak people in Indonesia's Central Kalimantan province
