▲ **1928: Fats Domino, U.S. singer-songwriter and pianist, was born in New Orleans**

1531: Up to 30,000 people died in an earthquake in Lisbon, Portugal

1815: Napoleon escaped from the island of Elba, planning to regain the throne of France

1951: The United States passed the 22nd Amendment, limiting the president to two four-year terms in office

2007: The International Court of Justice ruled that Serbia was guilty of failing to prevent genocide in the Srebrenica massacre of 1995, but cleared it of direct responsibility
