Likud



- **Leader:** Former premier Benjamin Netanyahu
- 1973: Likud founded as an alliance of four right-wing parties united under Menachem Begin
- 1977: Election victory marks first time left has lost power in Israel
- 2005: Following internal opposition over disengagement plan from Gaza Strip, Likud leader Prime Minister Ariel Sharon guits to form Kadima
- 2006: Likud suffers major election defeat when it wins just 12 seats
- Opposes return of Palestinian refugees to Israel. Insists that Jerusalem will remain Israel's undivided capital. Peace talks with Palestinians will take place only after improvement of West Bank economy
