▲ 1802: Sir Edwin Landseer, noted English animal painter and sculptor, was born

1793: France declared war on Spain during the French Revolution

1838: Famous operatic soprano Jenny Lind, known as the "Swedish Nightingale", made her debut

1989: A convicted U.S. murderer who had won an appeal against being sent to the electric chair was accidentally electrocuted while sitting on a prison toilet mending a pair of earphones

2008: Colombia confirmed that FARC leader Ivan Rios had been killed by his chief of security
