1733: English philosopher and scientist Joseph Priestley was born

1881: Tsar Alexander II of Russia was assassinated when a bomb was thrown at his carriage

1990: The Soviet parliament voted to end the political monopoly of the Communist Party after 72 years

2008: The body of Mar Paulos Faraj Rahho, the Chaldean Catholic archbishop of Mosul, Iraq, was found in a shallow grave near the city. He had been kidnapped on February 29
