1953: The Academy Awards ceremony was televised for the first time

1964: The Great St Bernard Tunnel under the Alps between Switzerland and Italy was opened to traffic

1996: Sarajevo became a united city again after four years when Bosnian and Croat authorities took control of the last district held by Serbs

2003: Operation Iraqi Freedom, the U.S.-led offensive to oust Saddam Hussein, began with a night raid by 40 Tomahawk missiles on Baghdad
