"Silent Assassin" goes to Afghanistan

British Army snipers call it the "Silent Assassin" – the L115A3 Long Range Rifle which, in recent weeks, has been targetting Taliban fighters in Afghanistan. Including technology used by the British Olympic shooting team, the rifle virtually guarantees "one shot, one kill" at ranges of 1,100m
