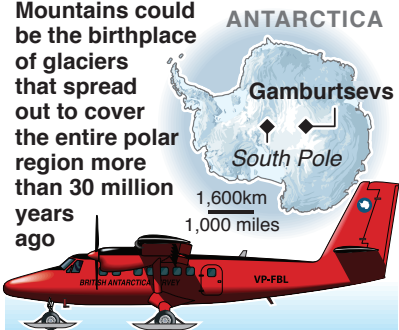


Antarctic “Alps” found

A mountain range the size of the Alps lying deep under the vast East Antarctic Ice Sheet has been surveyed in detail for the first time. Scientists believe the Gamburtsev Mountains could be the birthplace of glaciers that spread out to cover the entire polar region more than 30 million years ago
