▲ 1999: Germany's parliament met in the newly-restored Reichstag building in Berlin for the first time since before World War II

1882: English naturalist Charles Darwin, who developed the theory of evolution, died

1956: Prince Rainier of Monaco married movie star Grace Kelly

1993: The FBI siege of the Branch Davidian cult HQ at Waco, Texas, ended when cult members set fire to the compound; over 80 people died

1995: A car bomb tore apart a federal building in Oklahoma City, killing 168 people, including 19 children
