

# Commando-style attacks in South Asia

The attack against a police academy near the Pakistani city of Lahore is the latest in the region that suggests militants are increasingly using commando-style tactics to inflict maximum casualties and show they can strike at will

**1 Nov 26-29, Mumbai:** Islamist gunmen attack India's financial capital, killing over 170 people. India blames Pakistani militants

**2 Feb 11, Kabul:** Taliban militants kill 20 people in coordinated attack on three government buildings in Afghan capital

**3 Mar 3, Lahore:** Gunmen attack Sri Lanka cricket team with rifles, grenades and rockets, wounding seven players and a British coach and killing at least eight Pakistanis

**4 Mar 30, Lahore:** Militants armed with guns and grenades storm police training centre, killing at least 11 people. Eight gunmen killed when security forces recapture academy
