A Chinese spying network, dubbed *GhostNet* by the Toronto researchers who uncovered it, has been found to have taken over more than 1,000 computers in 103 countries, up to 30% in "high-value sites" including foreign ministries, embassies, international organizations and news media

"Social engineering" attack: User downloads *gh0st RAT* software either via web link to infected site or as email attachment

Trojan: Hacker gains access to internal files

Webcam, microphone: Hacker able to operate attached audio and video devices to monitor surroundings

Hacker can send and receive files
