New wave of Somali pirate attacks

So far this year, pirates have attacked 78 ships, successfully hijacking 19. Seventeen ships – with at least 285 crew – are currently being held for ransom in the area, according to the International Maritime Bureau

Apr 1: British Royal Navy reports diving boat *Indian Ocean Explorer*, with crew of seven, hijacked near Seychelles. Vessel and crew taken to Somali pirate base at Harardhere

2 Apr 4: Pirates hijack German freighter *Hansa Stavanger*. 24 crew members seized: five Germans, three Russians, two Ukrainians, two Filipinos and 12 Tuvalus

3 Apr 4: Taiwanese ship *Win Far 161* seized. Crew of 30 reported safe

4 Apr 5: Yemeni fishing boat with 13 crew members hijacked

5 Apr 6: British-owned bulk carrier *Malaspina Castle* hijacked with crew of 24, 16 of them Bulgarians

6 Apr 6: Taiwanese tuna fishing boat with 30 crew seized

11 Apr 14: Pirates seize Greek-managed bulk carrier *MV Irene EM*, with at least 21 crew, in rare overnight attack

12 Apr 14: Pirates in several speedboats capture Lebanese-owned cargo ship *MV Sea Horse*. Number of crew taken hostage not known

13 Apr 14: Pirates attack, but fail to hijack, second U.S. merchant ship, MV Liberty Sun (below). Twenty American crew members unharmed
