

Argentina claims vast seabed territory

Argentina has formally laid claim to a vast expanse of ocean, stretching as far as the Antarctic and including sovereignty over land disputed by Britain and Chile. The claim aims to extend the limit of the country's exclusive economic zone from 200 to 350 nautical miles off its coast



Foreign Minister **Jorge Taiana** says Argentina will object formally if UK presents claim to continental shelf around Falkland Islands

Countries wishing to lay claim to extensions of continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles have until May 13 to make submissions to UN
