▲ **1882:** Italian patriot Giuseppe Garibaldi, who played a key role in the unification of Italy by conquering Sicily and Naples in 1860, died

1924: The United States Congress granted U.S. citizenship to all native American Indians

1946: Italy abolished the monarchy and established a republic

1987: Spanish guitarist Andres Segovia, who established the guitar as a serious classical instrument, died

2008: The UN Security Council passed a declaration allowing foreign naval vessels to enter Somali territorial waters to deal with pirates
