▲ 1906: The Cunard passenger liner Lusitania, sunk by a German U-boat in 1915. was launched

1494: Spain and Portugal signed the Treaty of Tordesillas, agreeing to divide the New World between themselves

1948: President Edvard Benes of Czechoslovakia resigned rather than sign a new constitution legalising the country as a communist state

1981: Israeli warplanes attacked and destroyed the Osirak nuclear reactor at Al Tuwaitha in Iraq

2008: Hillary Clinton pulled out of the race for the White House, endorsing Barack Obama for U.S. President
