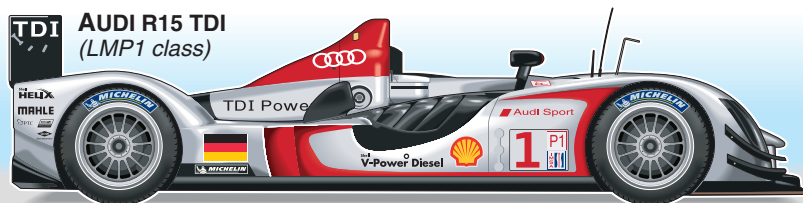


Audi newcomer enters race for Le Mans glory

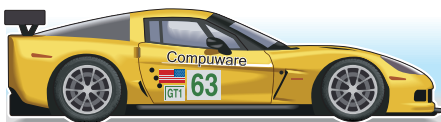
