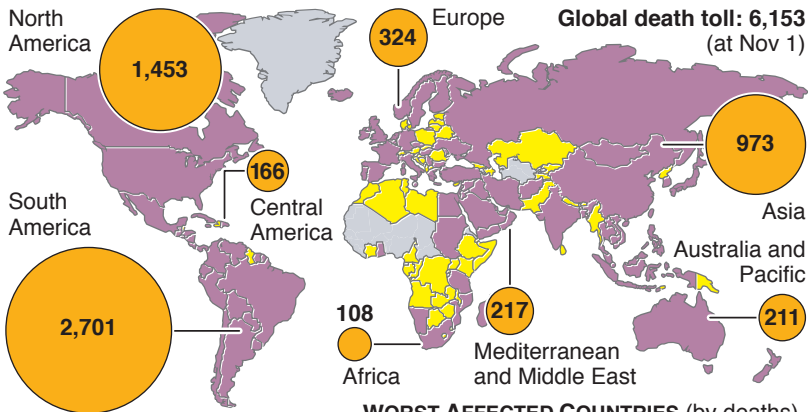


Death toll rising in second wave of H1N1 flu

With winter fast approaching in the northern hemisphere, the number of H1N1 influenza cases is expected to increase. Worldwide, more than 6,000 people have died since the virus first appeared in April
