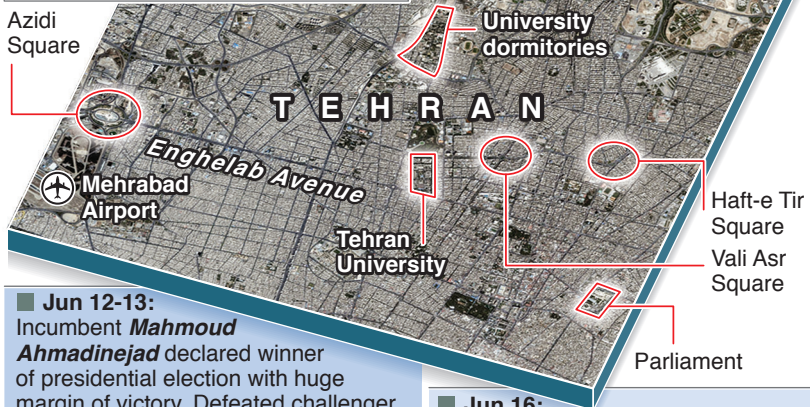


# Iran's week of political turmoil



■ **Jun 12-13:** Incumbent **Mahmoud Ahmadinejad** declared winner of presidential election with huge margin of victory. Defeated challenger **Mirhossein Mousavi** alleges fraud. Thousands of Mousavi's supporters clash with police

■ **Jun 14:** Supreme leader **Ayatollah Ali Khamenei** orders investigation into allegations of vote-rigging. Five students reported killed after **Basij** militia attacks dormitories at **Tehran University**

■ **Jun 15:** Hundreds of thousands of people defy ban to march and demonstrate in **Azidi Square**. Eight people killed on fringes of rally after crowd attacks Basij compound

■ **Jun 16:** Guardian Council says it is to carry out partial recount of ballots but rules out annulling poll. Thousands of pro-Mousavi demonstrators march in **Vanak Square**. Smaller number of Ahmadinejad's supporters stage counter-rally in **Vali Asr Square**

■ **Jun 17:** Opposition stages another rally in **Haft-e Tir Square**

■ **Jun 18:** Mousavi urges followers to stage peaceful protests or gather at mosques in day of mourning for people killed on Monday
