Honduras leader in new return bid

Deposed President *Manuel Zelaya* has launched a second attempt to return home by staging a dramatic border crossing from Nicaragua, defying government threats to arrest him and warnings the move will prompt bloodshed

CRISIS TIMELINE

Jun 28: President Zelaya overthrown by army and forced into exile in Costa Rica after seeking referendum to allow re-election of sitting presidents. Congress speaker Micheletti appointed interim president

Jun 29: U.S. President Obama says coup is illegal

Jul 4: *Organization of American States* suspends Honduras after interim authorities ignore ultimatum to reinstate Zelaya

Jul 5: At least one pro-Zelaya protester killed in clashes at Tegucigalpa's airport as Honduran troops block attempt by Zelaya to return home in plane provided by Venezuelan President **Hugo Chavez**

Jul 8: U.S. government suspends \$16.5m in military aid to Honduras

Jul 9: Micheletti and Zelaya travel to Costa Rica for talks mediated by President **Oscar Arias**

Jul 21: EU suspends more than \$90m in aid to Honduras

Jul 23: Delegations fail to reach agreement after three rounds of talks

July 25-26: Zelaya expected to attempt to return home after nearly one month in exile
