- Rasmussen born to farming family 1978: Elected to parliament
- 1992: Quits as tax minister after
- claims he misled parliament 2001: First elected Prime Minister.
 - Heads three consecutive centre-right governments until April 2009
- 2002: Leads negotiations resulting in 10 European countries joining EU in bloc's biggest enlargement to date
- 2003: Strong supporter of U.S.-led "war on terror", sends troops for invasion of Iraq and to Afghanistan
- Apr 2009: Appointed NATO's new Secretary General after overcoming Turkish objections over his stance on 2006 row triggered by publication in Danish newspapers of cartoons mocking Prophet Muhammad
- Aug 1: Rasmussen takes over from Jaap de Hoop Scheffer as **NATO Secretary General** Picture: Getty Images
