
Simon Cowell hits 50



- 1976: Gets job in mail room of recording giant EMI Music Publishing
- 1989: Offered position as A&R Consultant at BMG, where his signings include million-selling band Westlife
- 2001: Becomes judge on new UK talent show, Pop Idol. Brutally honest comments make him star of show
- 2002: Launches American Idol -"Mr Nasty" helps make show among highest-rated in U.S. TV history
- 2004: Launches The X Factor in UK, where winner receives £1m recording contract
- 2006: Got Talent format starts, has spawned spin-offs in over 20 countries
- 2009: Forbes Magazine estimates Cowell's 2008-09 earnings at \$75m
