

# Zune HD squares up to iPod nano

Apple's family of iPods and its iTunes online store have dominated the MP3 player market for almost a decade. Now, Microsoft hopes its Zune HD touchscreen media player will help it play catch up with the iPod nano

**Zune HD:** Superbright, low-power, OLED (organic light emitting diode) screen measures 84mm diagonally

**Browser:** Based on *Internet Explorer*, but no support for YouTube-format Flash videos

**Pins:** Quick links to content are kept in side menu off home screen

**Capacity:** Up to 8,000 songs (32GB version); 25,000 photos; 10 hours of high-definition video

**Battery:** 33hrs audio, 8.5hrs video

**Price:** \$220 (16GB); \$290 (32GB)

**iPod nano:** 56mm LCD screen

**FM radio:** Uses headphones as an antenna. **Live pause** feature stores up to 15 minutes of broadcast

**Camcorder:** With 16 special effects filters. Microphone with built-in speaker enables **Voice Memos**

**Pedometer:** Works with *Nike+iPod Sport Kit* to help meet fitness goals
