

Honduras suspends key civil liberties

Interim government leaders have suspended key civil liberties in response to calls for “insurrection” by ousted president Manuel Zelaya. Officials have also given Brazil 10 days either to grant Zelaya asylum, or hand him over



KEY DATES

■ Jun 28:

President Zelaya forced out of country

■ Jul 5:

Bid by Zelaya to return home by plane fails after troops block runway at Tegucigalpa airport

■ Jul 25-26:

Zelaya briefly crosses into country from Nicaragua but is turned back

■ Sep 21:

Zelaya sneaks into Brazilian embassy in Tegucigalpa

■ Sep 27:

Honduras issues 10-day ultimatum to Brazil and threatens to close embassy
