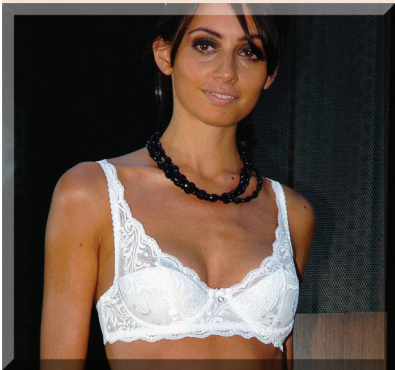

▲ **1913:** Mary Phelps Jacob patented the brassiere, the prototype constructed from two handkerchiefs and baby ribbon

1460: Portuguese prince Henry the Navigator died at the age of 66

1964: Pope Paul VI gave his jewelled tiara to the world's poor

1994: A 79-year-old golfer in Massachusetts dropped dead after hitting his first ever hole-in-one
