

▲ 1917: French sculptor Auguste Rodin, whose work includes his 1880 masterpiece. *The Thinker*, died

1905: Japan declared Korea a protectorate, giving the Japanese government control over Korea's foreign affairs

1922: The last Sultan of Turkey was deposed by Kemal Ataturk

1989: Thousands of people marched through Prague demanding an end to communist rule in Czechoslovakia

2008: Fighting resumed in Nord-Kivu province of the Dem. Rep. of Congo after a ceasefire was broken, leaving at least 150 civilians dead
