

Radovan Karadzic



■ **Jun 19, 1945:** Born in Montenegro

■ **1960:** Moves to Sarajevo

■ **1968:** Publishes collection of poetry

■ **1971:** Graduates as psychiatrist

■ **1990:** Co-founder of right-wing Serbian Democratic Party in Bosnia-Herzegovina

■ **1992-95:** Serves as president of Serb Republic in Bosnia. Supreme commander of armed forces during Bosnian war

■ **1995:** Indicted for war crimes and genocide by UN tribunal. Accused of masterminding 43-month siege of Sarajevo which led to 10,000 deaths and massacre of more than 7,000 Muslim men and boys at Srebrenica

■ **1996:** Karadzic goes into hiding

■ **2008:** Arrested in Belgrade while posing as New Age healer

■ **Oct 26, 2009:** Trial opens in The Hague – Karadzic faces 11 charges of genocide, war crimes and crimes against humanity
