Gilad Shalit timeline

- Jun 25, 2006: Israeli soldier *Gilad Shalit*, 19, seized in cross-border raid by Palestinian militants
- Jun 28: Israel invades Gaza Strip
 Sep 15: Letter from Shalit reaches his family via Egyptian mediators
- Jun 14, 2007: Hamas takes power in Gaza from Fatah forces loyal to President *Mahmoud Abbas*
- Jun 25: Audio tape from Shalit's captors asks for medical treatment and release of Palestinians
- Jun 9, 2008: Hand-written letter received by Shalit's family through former U.S. president *Jimmy Carter's* organization. Shalit says he suffers from "much depression"
- Jun 18: Hamas and Israel agree truce
- Dec 2008-Jan 2009:
- Truce breaks down. Israel launches 22-day offensive in Gaza Strip – 1,400 Palestinians
- and 13 Israelis are killed
- Mar 16: Intensive push for deal by outgoing Israeli premier *Ehud Olmert* fails © GRAPHIC NEWS Pictures: Getty



- Jun 23: Israel's new prime minister Benjamin Netanyahu says he is pushing for deal to release Shalit but denies reports that swap is imminent
- Aug: Egypt reveals Germany is also involved in negotiations
- Oct 1: Video delivered in exchange for release of 20 female prisoners gives conclusive proof that Shalit is alive and well
 - Nov 24: Hamas and Israel said to be close to agreement on list of hundreds of Palestinians who would be released in exchange for Shalit. List could include senior Fatah leader Marwan Barghouti (left)
