Demjanjuk case timeline



- 1952: Enters U.S. claiming he spent most of war as German prisoner
- 1977: Identified by survivors
 of Treblinka concentration camp
- as guard "Ivan The Terrible"

 1981: Stripped of U.S. citizenship
- 1981: Supped of 0.5. Citizenship
 1986: Extradited to Israel
- 1993: Israeli Supreme Court overturns conviction, ruling that he is not Ivan the Terrible
- 2002: Loses U.S. citizenship for second time after judge says there is proof he worked at Nazi camps
- 2009, May: Deported by U.S.
 Nov 30: Trial of Demjanjuk, now 89 charged with 27,900 counts of accessory to murder at Sobibor
