

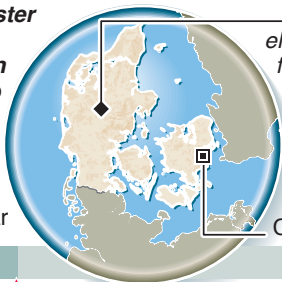
Green giant Denmark still expects global deal
