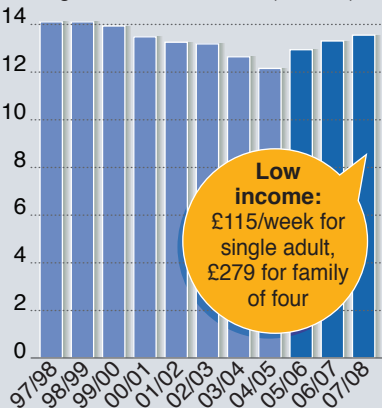


Poverty on the rise in UK

Poverty in Britain is at a nine year high. A new study finds that 13.4 million people – two in every nine Britons – are living in low income households. 2.5m people are unemployed, the highest level since Labour came to power in 1997
