The 17,000 people attending the 12-day conference will release over 40,500 tons of CO2 – equivalent to the entire annual output of the Pacific Island nation of Kiribati, which has 110,000 inhabitants



MEASURES TO MINIMISE FOOTPRINT

- Delegates to be offered tap water to avoid plastic bottle waste, free public transport, and guarantee that 65% of all food will be organic
- Fleet of 150 limousines running on fuel made from algae, bioethanol and hydrogen available for VIPs
- Traditional gift bags not to be given money spent instead on funding 11 university scholarships
- Denmark to offset summit's footprint by funding 20 efficient brick kilns in Bangladesh in \$1m deal overseen by World Bank
