1773: America's first public museum was established in Charleston, South Carolina

1990: Romania became the first East European state and Warsaw Pact member to outlaw the Communist Party

2009: An Indonesian ferry, the MV Teratai Prima, capsized and sank off Sulawesi, killing over 230 people
