Ukraine rivals line up for presidential election

Five years after its "Orange Revolution" promised to push Ukraine closer to western Europe, pro-Russian candidate Viktor Yanukovich looks to be on course to win the country's presidential election

Native Russian speaker. Initially declared winner of rigged 2004 election, he lost out in re-run of poll. Blames Orange Revolution for Ukraine's government corruption and dire economic performance
