The *USS Independence* is the U.S. Navy's first trimaran warship and the latest in its Littoral Combat Ship (LCS) class – fast, highly manoeuvrable vessels capable of tackling a variety of missions in coastal waters

Carries modules tailored to specific missions, such as anti-submarine, mine or surface warfare

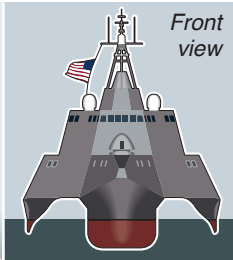
Flight deck
