▲ 1725: Peter the Great of Russia died, following a reign that saw Russia drawn increasingly into the European sphere of influence

1693: A charter was granted for the College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, Virginia

1904: The Russo-Japanese War began with a Japanese attack on the Russian fleet at Port Arthur

1937: General Franco captured Malaga during the Spanish Civil War

2006: An intact tomb dating back over 3,300 years was uncovered in Egypt's Valley of the Kings, the first since that of Tutankhamun in 1922
