1934: The Balkan Pact to prevent encroachment by the great powers was signed by Romania, Greece, Yugoslavia and Turkey

2009: A storehouse of 30 Egyptian mummies was unearthed inside a 2,600-year-old tomb at the vast necropolis of Saggara outside Cairo
