1745: Italian physicist, Count Alessandro Volta, who gave his name to a unit of electricity, was born

1930: Astronomer Clyde Tombaugh discovered the planet Pluto, now reclassified as a "dwarf planet"

1994: Phoolan Devi, India's "Bandit Queen", was released from jail after serving 11 years

2002: George Speight, leader of the May 2000 coup in Fiji, was jailed for life after pleading guilty to treason
