1901: The leaders of China's Boxer Rebellion, Chi-hsui and Hsu Cheng-yu, were beheaded in public

1980: Egypt and Israel established diplomatic relations, marking the end of 30 years of war between the two countries

2009: The Royal Bank of Scotland reported losses of £24.1 billion, the largest annual loss in British corporate history
