Obvious / widespread, > 40% **Evident but sporadic, 11-40%** **Scarce or non visible, 0-10%**

WFP has distributed food to over 200,000 people, but warns it could take up to one month for relief food to get to around 2 million people in need

City water system only partially functional – tanker trucks beginning to deliver water to larger camps

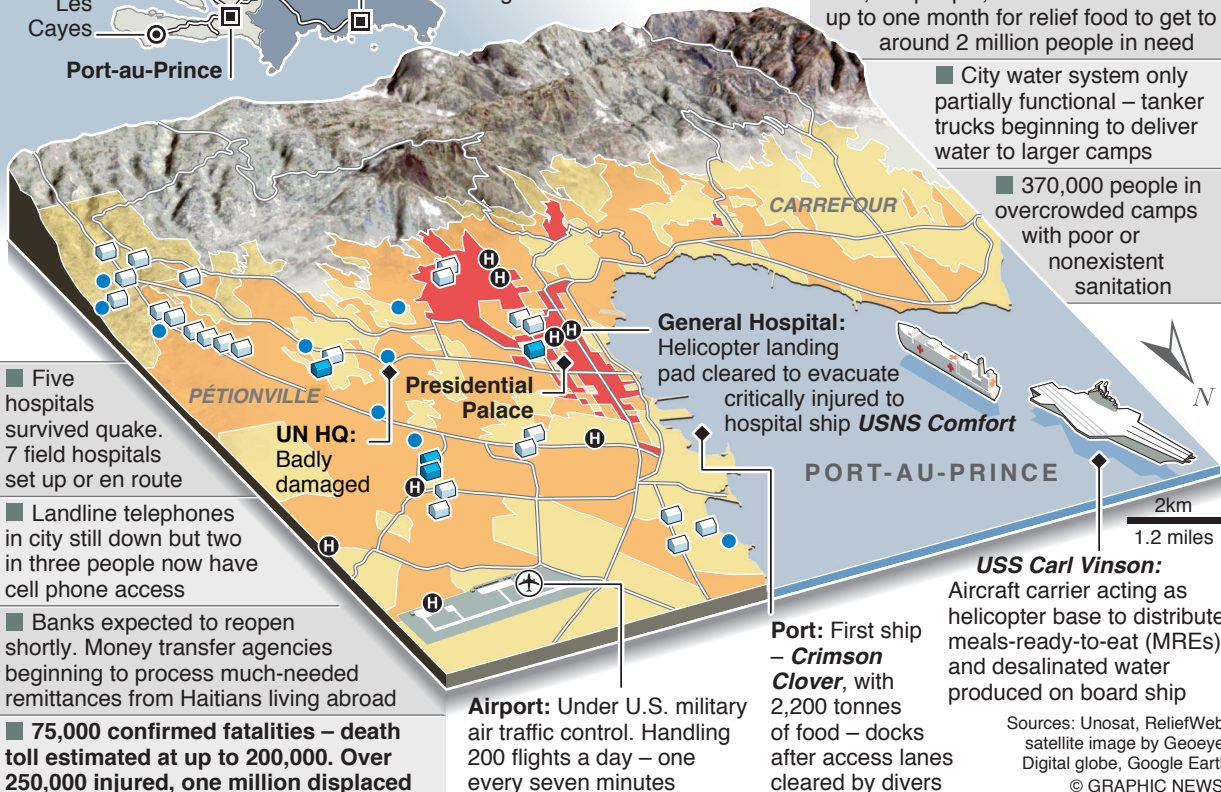
370,000 people in overcrowded camps with poor or nonexistent sanitation

Five hospitals survived quake. 7 field hospitals set up or en route

Landline telephones in city still down but two in three people now have cell phone access

Banks expected to reopen shortly. Money transfer agencies beginning to process much-needed remittances from Haitians living abroad

75,000 confirmed fatalities – death toll estimated at up to 200,000. Over 250,000 injured, one million displaced
